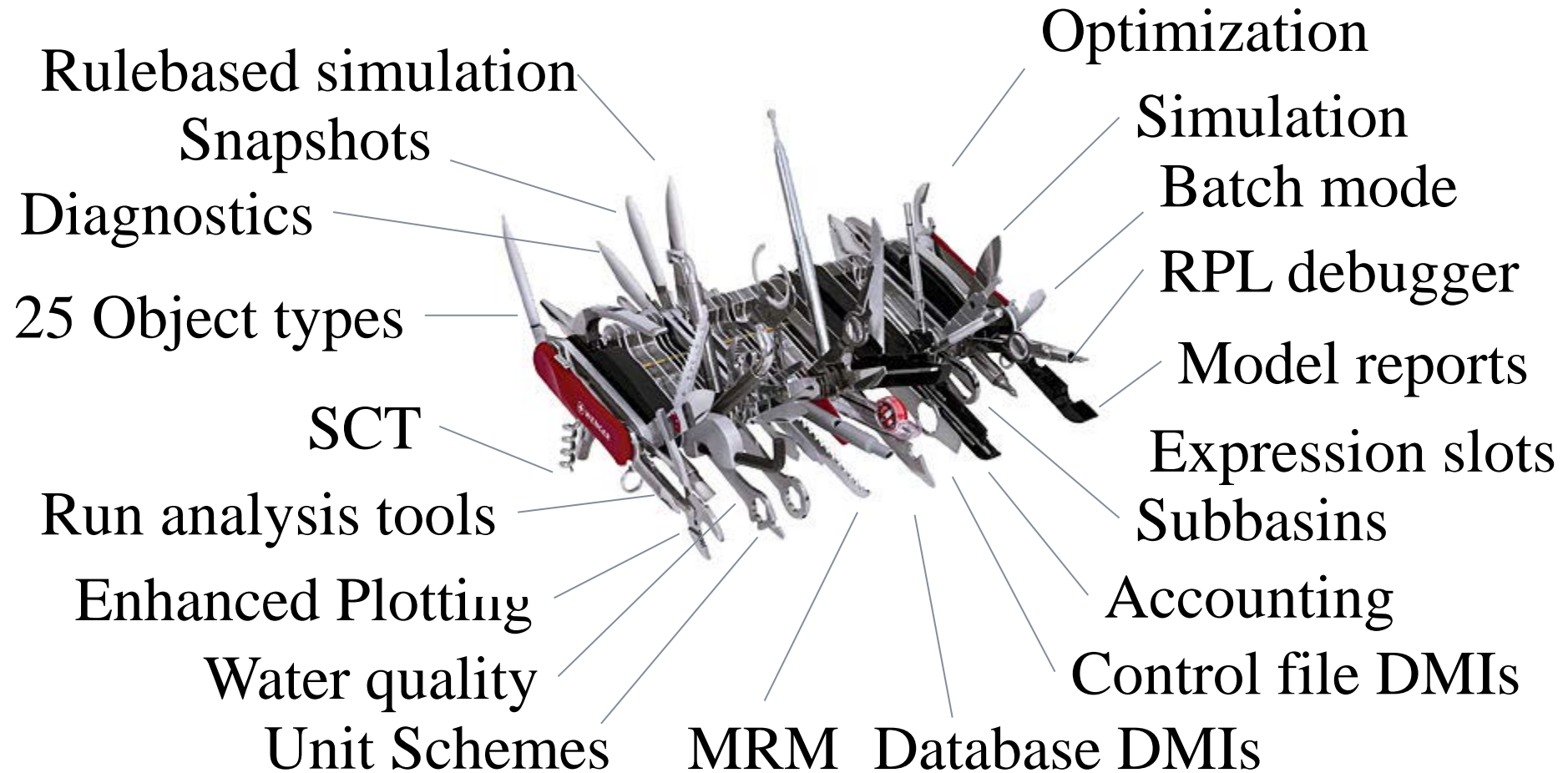

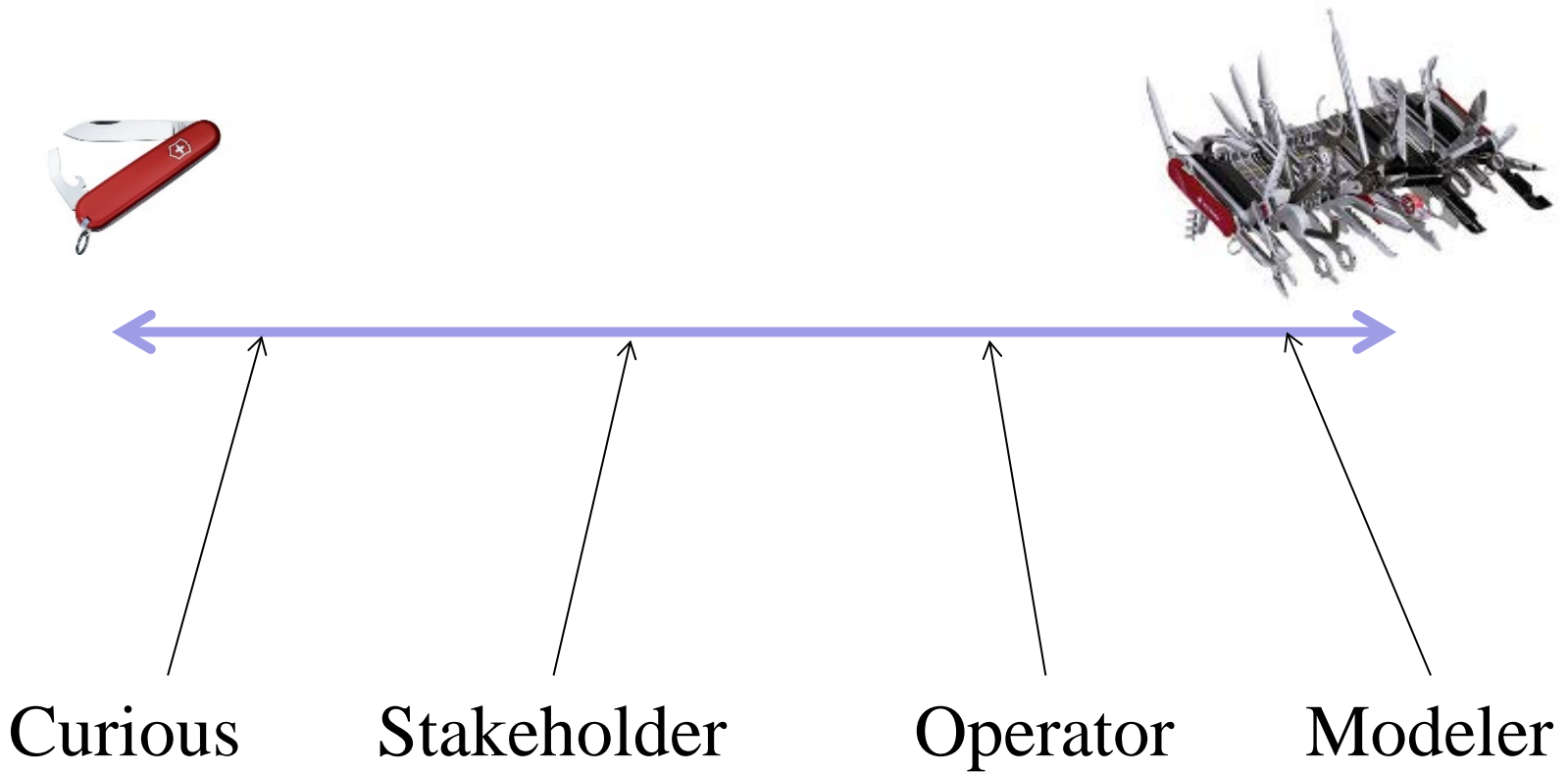

- Users repeat themselves
- Memory limitations
- Tedium
- Checklists anyone?



Opacity and Repeatability

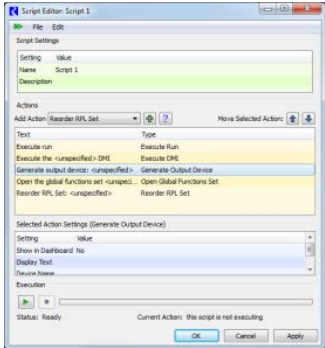
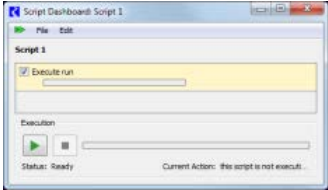
- Opacity and model state
 - Have I imported values?
 - Has my coworker run this DMI?
- Repeatability
 - How do I replicate a previous run?
 - Why are the outputs different this time?

Solution: Scripts

- Script = user-defined sequence of actions
- Action = common RiverWare operation
 - Open a slot
 - Run a DMI
 - Set controller
- Extensible
 - RiverWare 6.5: 24 action types
 - RiverWare 6.6: 5 new action types
- Two interfaces

- Update model run range
 - Move up a day
 - Switch to new water year
- Switch model between applications
 - Accounting vs Operations vs Planning
- Model verification
 - Run many scenarios automatically

Motivation Revisited

- Complexity: Configurable dashboard
- Repetition: Create once, execute often
- Opacity: Execution defines state
- Repeatability: Script captures operations
